This year marks our 18th year of holding the sale in Sussex County, first in Lafayette and for the past 6 years at the Farmers Market on the Sussex County Fairgrounds. This year has of course come with its own set of challenges, not only due to Covid-19, but the super cold weather we had in early May; we even had snow on May 9th! We are providing you the following guidelines before your come to our annual sale.

GUIDELINES for the Heirloom Tomato & Veggie Plant Sale due to covid-19

1. If you exhibit any of the CDC's covid-19 symptoms, PLEASE STAY HOME!
2. There will only be 1 Entrance in – 1 Exit out.
Entrance will be on the double-door side with the cobblestone walkway
Exit will be on the barn door side facing the fairgrounds
3. All customers MUST wear face coverings
4. Please do not bring anyone with you unless they are shopping also
5. If we have to limit the number of customers in the building, we will to ensure social distancing
6. We are spreading out our usual display of plants, again to ensure social distancing. They will be grouped as we usually do; eggplants, peppers, herbs, veggie packs in their own sections and the tomato varieties up and down the aisles.
7. If you have your own box or tray to bring, bring it. All plants must be counted at checkout. Our team members will be using hand sanitizer before each customer checkout. We have plastic trays that you can use to shop with, and your order may be transferred into a smaller sized box at checkout. All of our trays will then be dipped into a bleach bath and put back out for other customers to use.
8. We will have 6' tape marks on the floor by checkout – PLEASE observe these marks.
9. Be respectful of other customers and our team as you shop
10. Your patience is a must as we all work together during this process. We have an amazing team who have worked diligently on growing our plants for you! Though we may not be able to see your smiles, a simple thank you to our team members would be appreciated!
